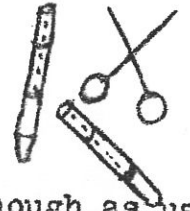
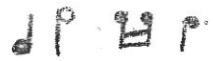
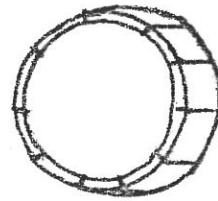


BAND

Our thanks must go to Mr. Hurrell who, during this year, has helped the band a great deal in many ways.

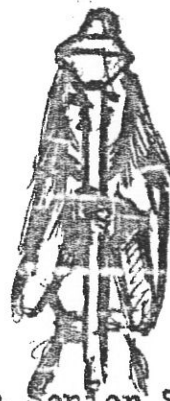
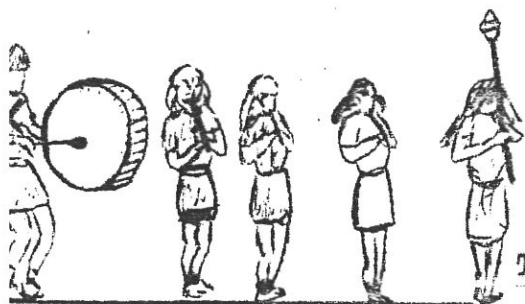

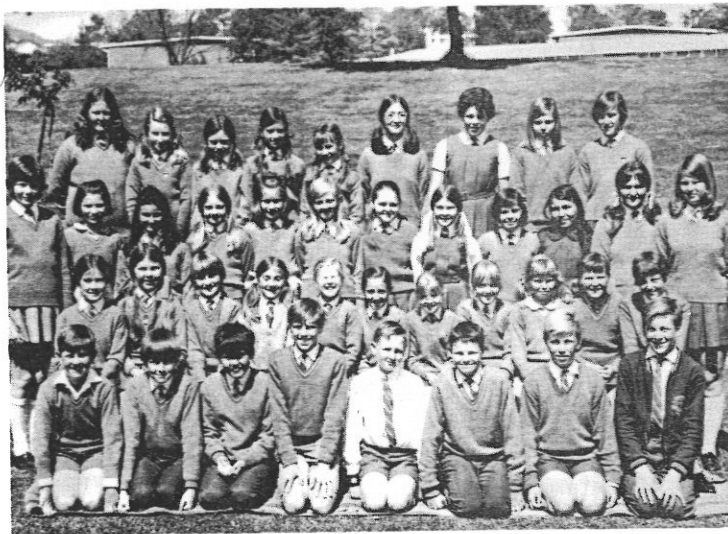
THE SENIOR STUDY ROOM
